Name of Project: *Karmadev-Phukot 400 kV Double Circuit Transmission Line*

- i. Government of Nepal (GoN) has allocated fund for Rastriya Prasaran Grid Company Limited (RPGCL) toward the cost of Karmadev-Phukot 400 kV Double Circuit Transmission Line Project and intends to apply a portion of this fund to eligible payments under the Contract for which this Expression of Interest is invited for International Consulting Service.
- ii. The RPGCL now invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from interested and eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to provide the following consulting services:
Detail survey study and design of
 - a. 400kV D/C New Karmadev (Indo-Nepal Border) — Dododhara (New Lamki) — Betan (Surkhet) — Phukot (Kalikot) about 130 km long transmission line
 - b. Associated substations at Phukot (400/132 kV) and Betan (loop-in-out)

The completed EOI documents received by the due date and within the specified time shall be opened at 14:00 (NST) September 15, 2017 in the presence of the applicants or their authorized representative who-so-ever wish to attend. Absence of the applicant or their authorized representatives, however, shall not obstruct or prevent the opening of the EOI in any way.
- viii. EOI will be assessed based on Qualification (30%), Experience (60%) and Capacity (10%) of consulting firm. Based on evaluation of EOI, only shortlisted firms will be invited to submit technical and financial proposal through a request for proposal.
- ix. Minimum score to pass the EOI is 65%.
- x. RPGCL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all EOI applications with or without giving any reason whatsoever.
- xi. The procedure for e-GP submission of EOI application is given in Appendix A2.
